

TOURNAMENT RULES

PLAYERS CHECK

- Before the start of the tournament, the team leader must submit to the tournament organisation an official list of players, one list per team, including players' name, surname, date of birth and shirt number.
- All players, team leaders and managers must be in possession of an original identity document (ID card or passport; photocopies of the documents are not accepted), which must be presented upon request at any time.
- Each player can only play for one team in each category for the entire duration of the tournament. The use of a player in more than one team of the same category will result in a forfeit loss for the team involved.

U13	On passes from teammates the goalkeeper cannot catch the ball with his hands. If the goalkeeper catches the ball with his hands in the penalty area after a pass from his teammates, an indirect free kick will be awarded at the point where he caught the ball.	The penalty kick is taken from a distance of 9 metres from the goal line.	Goalkeeper distribution is permitted with both hands and feet and can reach beyond the halfway line. The goalkeeper may not hold the ball in their hands for more than 6 (six) seconds. If the goalkeeper puts the ball on the ground, they may not pick it up again with their hands.	The goalkeeper can be pressured when receiving the ball from teammates.	Yellow cards are issued. A player may be sent off (given a red card) for particularly serious misconduct. During the half in which the sending-off occurs, the team must continue with one fewer player. The sent-off player can be replaced in the following half.	Direct and indirect free kicks, the defensive wall at 9 meters.
